They have the opportunity to visit the Branch of CARN in the Volta Region to interact with the staff there and to see the state of affairs also there. CRAN Freundeskreis gave CRAN Ghana a loan to purchase a combine harvester and two power tillers as a way of investment so that CRAN could use it to generate some income to support the organization’s work. CRAN Freundeskreis also gave CRAN money to construct a six unit classroom block for the people in the Anthony community. During their visit, they had the opportunity to visit the school project also to see the progress. They were very happy about the project though it has fallen back a little in terms of date of completion.

The construction of a six-unit classroom block for Anthony School in the Kakum National Park area in the Central Region is on course. The building has reached the letting level and the necessary laying of the iron rods is been done concurrently with the block laying. The community has contributed immensely towards the construction of the building as they are providing communal labor as well as wood and also along the line, mixing concrete. They have provided all the wood needed for the project. Gerd and his daughter Julia were at the scene to observe things for themselves and to also appreciate work done so far. We are by this development, expecting work to be complete as scheduled.

CRAN PROVIDES MATERIALS FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN

It is the beginning of another academic year and CRAN as usual has come to the aid of our sponsored children. This is in a form of providing them with the materials they need for their academic work. Items such as note books, exercise books, pens, pencils, rulers, etc, (the list cannot be fully provided since it is very long) have been supplied to all our children in the basic level. Those at the SHS who are in SHS 2 and above have had their fees paid. We also provided the lunch subsidy to the children at the basic level (primary and JHS) so that they can buy some lunch during the school hours. The lunch subsidy is provided every term to enable the children find food every lunch time to make schooling much more enjoyable for them because some of these children come to school without eating at home since they do not have anyone to give them food.
