UPDATE ON THE CARI PROJECT

On the 18th to 19th November 2015, CRAN was invited together with two other organizations Wora Mill and Christian Aid on the Competitive African Rice Initiative (CARI) project for training on various mediums available for fund raising.

SANKA AND DUAKOR CRAN NURSERY CLOSES DOWN

Sanka CRAN Kindergarten was established by CRAN in 1995. The school was then handed over to Sanka Community to manage. CRAN has supported the community to maintain the school over the years.

This academic year (2015/2016), the government of Ghana completed a new Kindergarten for Sanka Public Basic School, as a result of this, all the children from Sanka CRAN Kindergarten have moved to that school. The community leaders thereafter decided to close down the school.

Duakor CRAN Nursery was established in 2010 to provide good learning pre-school foundation for children. The school has currently been close down. This was largely because parents were not committed to paying token school fees for their wards. Moreover since preschool is not a condition for admission to kindergarten there was no urgency attached by parents.

The teacher, Margaret Akaba who laboured with the school since its inception also went on early retirement.

The people of Sanka and Duakor community are grateful to CRAN and all donors who have supported the schools over the years.
