Emmanuel Asifo Okyere, one of the early beneficiaries of BHA educational development support has passed the recent 2020 West African Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (WASSCE) with distinction. He obtained the following results:

He was sponsored through the Junior High School where he passed to the Presbyterian Boys Senior High School in Legon, Accra. At the recent 2020 examination he passed successfully and he is waiting for admission to study BSC Administration (Finance & Accounting) at the University of Ghana Business School, Legon.

He wants to become a Chartered Accountant and an auditor to enable him work with any of the top four International Audit Firms (Deloitte, Ernst & Young, KPMG or Price Water House Coopers).

He has appealed to BHA to support him with his first-year admission fees to the University.

ERNESTINA DANSOA SEEKS SUPPORT TO STUDY AT THE TEACHER TRAINING COLLEGE



Ernestina Dansoa, one of the early beneficiaries of BHA has also passed her recent 2020 "WASSCE" examination. She tried to sell liquid soap at the market during the Corona Virus pandemic and she managed to save GHC50 (7Euros) after **three months** of selling. She used the money to buy an application form to apply for admission to the training college.

Ernestina who is 20years of age has lost the mum and her dad is terminally ill with stroke and bedridden. All hope to raise money to continue her education has proved futile.

Her dream is to become a teacher. Currently, she has been offered admission to the Seventh Day Adventist college of Education to

study to become a teacher, but her greatest obstacle is how to raise money to pay her admission fee of GHC 2,596.30 (366.04Euros) excluding other incidental expenses.

She has appealed to BHA support him with his first-year admission fees to the training college.

BHA CONSTRUCTS PLATFORMS FOR WATER STORAGE TANKS (POLYTANKS)



On Wednesday, 16th of September, 2020, A team of four staff went to the Essuekyir community to meet the chief and elders of the community. Staff present were Mr. Teye Kodzi, Mr. Ralph Kyei, Miss Herberta Minnow and Mr. Eric Acheampong (Civil Engineer).

In the month of October, BHA donated four water storage tanks to the chief and people of Essuekyer community in the central region.

BHA had to construct a concrete platform which will permanently hold these storage tanks. With the advice of the elders of the community, four of the platforms were strategically constructed and positioned to serve all members of the community.

Essuekyir is a rural community under the Effutu Municipal Assembly in the Central Region. It has a population of about 3,500. The people are predominately farmers, fisherman and petty traders. Essuekyir has four Suburbs in the same community. These are Abuja, Suprufa, Abura and Oyhina.



Originally, BHA decided to donate two of the polytanks but the chief and the elders pleaded for a donation of four so that all the suburbs will benefit from the water storage facility.



The construction of the platforms is likely to be completed by the 10th of December 2020 and shall be commissioned by 17th December 2020. The chief and people of the community supported with sand and stones for the construction.
