DONATION OF PACKED FOOD TO INMATES AND OFFICERS OF THE ANKAFUL INFECTIONS DISEASE PRISON



The Blue Horizon Aid (BHA), made a donation of packed food to the inmates and the officers of the Infectious Disease Prison section of the Ankaful Prison in Cape Coast, the Central Region of Ghana. The donation was done on the 24th of December 2020 as part of the organization's core humanitarian drive. This forms a very important part of the organization as it seeks to support the needy and vulnerable in our society.

There was a total of one hundred and

forty-six people made of sixty-two inmates and eighty-four prison officers involved. Each of them was given the packed food as part of Christmas celebration. The BHA does not want such special groups of people to be left out in the celebration of the festive season.

BHA was represented by Mr. and Mrs. Teye Kodzi. Mr. Kodzi is the project officer of the organization. Mrs. Kodzi accompanied him to serve as a support.

Receiving the items on behalf of the inmates and the officers, Supt. Roger Azanya, the director of this part of the prison expressed his appreciation on behalf of the rest of recipients and prayed the blessings of God for the entire team of BHA for remembering them in such a wonderful way. He recounted the fact that this donation was the second in the year 2020 and wished God's grace for the organization to enable BHA continue its good work in the coming year.

Supt. Roger Azanya gave the BHA representations the opportunity to share a message with the inmates. Mrs. Kodzi shared a message that talked about Jesus' birth and the reason for His coming into the world, which is to save the lives of sinners. She said since we are all sinners, we all need Jesus in our lives. She encouraged the inmates to submit their hearts to Christ so that He will enable them to live lives acceptable in the sight of God.

When the BHA team exchanged further pleasantries including taking of group photographs, they departed with joy and gratitude in their hearts to God for the opportunity to do something for the needy.

BHA donated food items to widows, disabled, aged, the sick and other underprivileged people in the Weija community in Accra on New Year's Day of 1st Jan 2021. The food items include bags of rice, oil and drinks. Mr Eric Turkson, a banker by profession and the brother of the Exec Director of BHA did the presentation on behalf of BHA.

In his presentation, he mentioned that Christmas and this festive season is the time for giving. He said God so loved the world that He gave his only begotten son that whosoever believed in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. God

unconditionally gave us His son Jesus to die and save us from our sins, therefore Christians must also learn to give unconditionally.

TITLE: PLACE YOUR ULTIMATE TRUST IN THE LORD

Memory Verses:

PSALMS 121:1-2 - "I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help My help cometh from the Lord, which made heaven and earth"

While it lies on the rock facing the sun with no feathers and its skin at the mercy of the sun, the eagle bangs its beak on the rock. Remember the beak is a source of power. It is with the beak that the eagle fights, attacks prey and rips through flesh. Due to its effectiveness, the eagle has a great deal of confidence in its beak. From birth, the beak has been reliable in winning the fights it has been involved in. The beak has played a significant role in overpowering its prey.
