TITLE: CREATED FOR HIS PLEASURE


REVELATION 4:11

Tarkwa-Nsuaem Municipal District is one of the fourteen districts in Western Region of Chana. Originally it was formerly part of the then-largest Wassa West District in 1988, which was created from the former Wassa Fiase-Mpohor District Council, until the northern part of the district was split off to create Prestea-Hunl Valley District 29 February 2008; thus, the remaining part of the district has been renamed as Tarkwa-Nsuaem District, which was later elevated to municipal district assembly status on the same year to become Tarkwa-Nsuaem Municipal District. The municipality is located in the eastern part of Western Region and has Tarkwa as its capital town.
