In this chapter Blue Horizon Aid's Vocational Training Development Skills presents a promising innovative training program related to Carpentry for the youth.

The beauty of carpentry training is that it is practical oriented whereby you get to use your mind and hands to design and produce a particular object or product and bring it to life. To begin with, it is believed that there is more to carpentry than just sawing and nailing wood.

Carpentry is a skilled trade and a craft in which the primary work performed is cutting, shaping and installation of building materials during the construction of buildings, ships, timber bridges, concrete and framework, etc.

BHA made a trip to Timber market to partner Ensaam Woodworks to deliver vocational and technical education that will create employment opportunities for the jobless, out of school, youth in and around the surrounding areas of the Ashaiman municipality. This is a wellknown settlement population, estimated to number between some hundred thousand up to over one million people. It has grown to become one of the viable destinations for business because of the population that lives within the constituency.

BHA is willing to offer vocational training for the youth with the help of Ensaam Woodworks to help them create self-employment. The trade could be used to generate income and could be used to support themselves in a tertiary institution, perhaps help parents and other siblings or even serve as a source of funding for one's business in the future if they decide to build a career from such skills. This great endeavor is likely to provide jobs for over 1000 youth.

A career in carpentry is a stable, rewarding and challenging way to earn a good living in Ashaiman. Many of its inhabitants are school drop outs and are known to engage in extremely bad vices. The underlying goal for this partnership program is to help young people obtain the resources they need to exit joblessness permanently. Blue Horizon Aid's Technical and Vocational Training Development Skills is an engaging program in which students will be assisted in learning to acquire skills and knowledge related to the trades.

It will aid students to gain valuable hands-on experience in important trades. In addition, it is to empower and to assist them build knowledge and develop entrepreneurial skills.

Mr Emmanuel Adjei Nyanu who is the owner of Ensaam Woodworks and has been working in the field for over 30 years. His workshop is located in Timber market in Ashaiman. It is believed by many that apprenticeships are the best way to learn the skill of carpentry, he said.He also mentioned that he had witnessed many vices involving the youth and it has been a dream to help them. He is overjoyed for the opportunity and honored to be partnering BHA to realize this dream of supporting vocational and technical education among the youth of Ashaiman.
