Scripture Reading: Luke 1

Then the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. *Luke 1:30-31

Consider the angel Gabriel’s words to Mary.

Do not be afraid. When you consider Gabriel’s greeting, you can well understand why Mary was perplexed and afraid: “Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you!” Why would an angel come to greet her? In what way was she “highly favored” by God? How was God with her? Do not be afraid to accept what God says about you. Sometimes when you tell people your dreams they get afraid for you; you tell people what you are going to do and they fear for you because nobody has done it before; and who knows, you may be the originator so don't be afraid to accept it. Most of us have accepted who we say we are and not who God says we are. We have accepted who our parents and friends say we are and not who God says we are.

You have found favour with God. Why would God choose an unknown teenage girl to advance His purpose for humanity? There is no satisfactory answer to this question other than that God simply chose Mary, and that is what favour means. God’s favour is when He chooses an unlikely person to accomplish His purpose.

Mary was probably the last person anyone suspected would have carried out this assignment, and yet God chose her. Just like Mary, God has chosen you. You are the unlikely candidate for God’s favour.

You will conceive and give birth to a Child. When God starts with you He doesn't look at your qualification, family history or education; when God gets ready, virgins shall conceive. In the miracle we are talking about, God could have gone to some woman who already had three children and Jesus would have been her fourth child, and that would be no miracle; but God took that which nobody had touched and used it for His glory.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, I receive the favour to do the impossible. Help me do all things you have called me to do. In Jesus’ name, Amen!_ Sent from my iPhone
