The deadline for the Millennium Development Goals is fast approaching. We have a responsibility to make sure we fulfil the promise we made at the beginning of the millennium: to ensure that boys and girls everywhere complete a full course of primary schooling.

The challenge is daunting. Many of those who remain out of school are the hardest to reach, as they live in countries that are held back by conflict, disaster, and epidemics. And the last push is unlikely to be accompanied by the double-digit economic growth in some developing economies that makes it easier to expand opportunities.

Nevertheless, we can succeed. Over the past few years Blue Horizon Aid in partnership with Ghana Freundeskreis have not relent on their efforts to restore hope to the hopeless. This year over forty children from various communities in Ghana have received support in the area of textbooks, notebooks, exercises books pens, pencils, erasers, rulers and other learning materials. The children are also fed one meal a day when they go to school. This is to facilitate the learning of the children as they cannot learn on an empty stomach.

The communities include Mfuom, Abrafo, Ampemkro, all in the Twifo Hemang Lower Denkyira in the central region as well as some children in the Cape Coast Municipality. Others communities are Lashibi and Klagon all in the Greater Accra Region

He moved from the village to the city without knowing where he was going or where to sleep. He dropped out of school and life became very tough for him.

The Lord however, ordered his steps and he met the Exec Dir of BHA and hope was restored to him. He went back to Junior High School, passed successfully to the Senior High School and now studying Law at the University...
