Monthly Devotional Guide

HONOUR THE LORD

1 Samuel 2:30 “Wherefore the LORD God of Israel saith, I said indeed that thy house, and the house of thy father, should walk before me for ever: but now the LORD saith, Be it far from me; for them that honour me I will honour, and they that despise me shall be lightly esteemed.”

When God makes a promise to you, He keeps it to the very end because He is a faithful God. However, there are circumstances that warrant Him to break His promises or to change His mind: one such instance is when we dishonour the Lord.

When we dishonour the Lord and exhaust His long-suffering, He takes back His promises and turns it to another who will honour Him. It is therefore important for us to know how to honour the Lord.

Here are three ways to honour the Lord:

1. Honour the Lord with your substance.

Proverbs 3:9-10 “Honour the LORD with thy substance, And with the firstfruits of all thine increase: So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, And thy presses shall burst out with new wine.”

God promises to bless us financially and materially if we honour Him with the best of our financial and material substance. Though Peter didn't really know who Jesus was when he gave his fishing boat to Him to preach, Jesus honoured this promise in Peter's life by giving him an abundant catch of fish.

2. Honour God's laws.

Proverbs 28:9 “He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer shall be abomination.”

God and His Word are one. To honour God, we must honour His word and His laws. If you turn your ears away from hearing God's laws and you reject His commandments, then God will also despise and reject your prayers because you cannot ask favours from somebody you clearly despise. Honour God's laws and He will honour your prayers with answers.

3. Honour God's servant and people.

Matthew 10:40 “He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.”

The Lord still continues His life, ministry and work through His people and therefore, He expects to be honoured through His servants and disciples. As we treat His servants and disciples honourably, He is honoured but if we despise His servants and even the least of His disciples, we despise the Lord in heaven. Honour the Lord's servants and disciples and you will not lose your reward.

Precious one, remember that the Lord will honour those who honour Him but will lightly esteem those who despise Him. If you want your prayers and desires to carry weight in His sight, then honour the Lord.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, I purpose in my heart to honour You always by the help and wisdom of Your Spirit through Your Word, in Jesus' name. Amen.
