Overcome Bitterness: Three Steps to Freedom

Ephesians 4:31 (NLT)"Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior."

When we experience betrayal or mistreatment, it is natural to feel bitter. However, holding onto bitterness only harms ourselves, leading to anger, resentment, and destructive thoughts. Let us explore three steps to release bitterness and find freedom:

#### 1. Let God reveal it

Often, we believe we are free from bitterness, but Jeremiah 17:9 reminds us that the heart is deceitful. We must allow God's Holy Spirit to perform radical surgery on our hearts, exposing any hidden bitterness. Only God can truly reveal the state of our hearts.

#### 2. Let Grace uproot it

Bitterness is never the appropriate response to someone's wrongdoing. Instead, we should seek forgiveness from God and extend forgiveness to others. By relying on God's grace, we can uproot bitterness completely from our hearts, allowing healing to take place. Ephesians 4:32 (NIV) - "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."This verse reminds us of the grace we have received from God through the forgiveness of our sins. As God has forgiven us, we are called to extend that same grace and forgiveness to others. By relying on God's grace, we can uproot bitterness and replace it with forgiveness.

#### 3. Let peace replace It

prews 12:14 instructs us to pursue peace with all people, as it is with holiness. When someone offends us, responding with rather than offense demonstrates holiness. Holding onto only keeps us bound, while forgiveness sets both parties free.

Precious one, remember, bitterness hinders the flow of God's grace in our lives. It is time to break free. Allow God to reveal any bitterness within you, let His divine grace uproot it, and replace it with peace.

#### Prayer

Heavenly Father, I ask for healing in my heart and the strength to let go of bitterness. Grant me the grace to forgive and experience the freedom that comes from releasing all bitterness, in Jesus' name.

## THE ESSENCE OF CLEANLINESS



Blue Horizon Aid strongly believes that maintaining cleanliness among students is very crucial. BHA stumbled upon some students of Kotobabi No.2 JHS during a visit to

the school who were diligently cleaning cooking pots they had brought from home. This was an exercise given to the students to clean the black cooking pot to bring out the original colour(silver).



In most cases, only the inside of the pots is cleaned, while the outside is left uncleaned for several months, causing the pots to become very black.

The students were taught in school how to use local substances like ash, lime, and metal sponges to clean the dirty pots.
